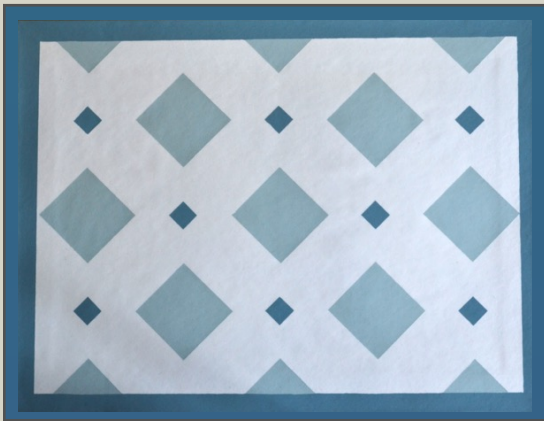


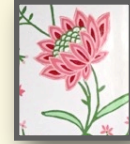
## Expert Craftsmanship

**THE PROCESS:** Starting with a #8-18oz heavy weight canvas, both sides are primed, sanded and given 2-3 coats of base color. The 2" hem is glued and corners are mitre-cut. I then apply the design and paint 2 coats. Finally, 4 coats of Satin Floor Poly finishes the mat.

**EASY CARE:** with soap and water.

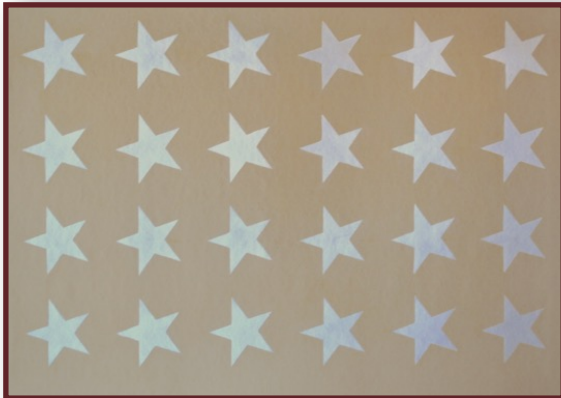

Painted floorcloths have a long history, first produced en masse in Europe prior to the mid 1700's. They were used in summer months when wool carpets were removed from homes to be cleaned and stored, and used under carpets in winter months to add insulation. Our earliest Presidents had painted floorcloths in their home inventories. Floorcloths were a very popular way to decorate a room without the expense of a carpet. However with the introduction of linoleum, floorcloths all but vanished from domestic use. But now, they are coming back!

Floorcloths provide an elegant and fun alternative to carpets with infinite range of color & design combinations. They can be matched or paired to wallpapers or fabrics. Custom mats can compliment kitchen curtains, tile patterns or a special painting. Size, color and design determines price.
